## Dynamic Dann now a world champion

Coast trier bringing home a swag of medals from Taekwon-Do Junior World Championships

**S**HE'S only 16, but she's already a world champion. Corrie Dinn, 16, from the Taekwon-Do club at the Coast Community Centre, has won a gold medal in the women's power breaking and a silver medal in the women's sparring at the Taekwon-Do Junior World Championships in Seoul, South Korea.

Dinn, who has been training for three years, was one of the youngest competitors at the event. She won her gold medal in the women's power breaking category, a feat that earned her a place in the Guinness Book of World Records.

"I was really nervous at first, but once I started, I knew this was my chance to shine," Dinn said. "I was so happy to win, and I'm proud to represent my club and my country."

Her coach, Mr. Jon Sawden, said Dinn's success was a result of her hard work and dedication. "Corrie is a natural talent, but she's also a very hard worker. She practices every day, and she's always looking to improve herself."

Dinn plans to continue her training and compete in more international events. "I want to be a world champion in all my categories," she said. "I'm going to keep working hard and never give up."
