#### Welcome

Welcome to the sixth issue of the 2011 ITF World Championships Newsletter. #### **Payment Dates – Accommodation**

If your team have booked accommodation through Travel@ITFNewZealand2011.com please remember that team managers need to arrange to pay the deposit and full payment to the Travel Account by the following dates:

- All deposits are required by 15 January 2011 to confirm your booking
- Unless a prior agreement has been made with Travel@ITFNewZealand2011.com then <u>full</u> payment needs to be made by 22nd January 2011

The deposit and full payment for accommodation must be made in New Zealand dollars to the Travel Account. Team Managers should contact Travel@ITFNewZealand2011.com for account details, and for advice on arranging a telegraphic transfer to the Travel Account.

If your Delegation and supporters haven't already booked accommodation, please contact Travel@ITFNewZealand2011.com now to pay and secure your hotel accommodation. Accommodation is filling fast, and we want to make sure that everyone travelling to Wellington for the 2011 ITF World Championships has suitable accommodation close to the TSB Bank Arena!

#### **Spectator Tickets on Sale Now**

Spectator tickets are now available for purchase at Ticketek. You can purchase single day tickets online at http://premier.ticketek.co.nz over the counter at any of Ticketek's New Zealand outlets, or by calling 0800 TICKETEK or 0800 842538. Adult tickets are only \$15, and there are great discounts for family groups, children under 11, and seniors.

If you're planning on attending 2 or more days of the tournament, you can save money by purchasing a multi-day discount pass. The multi-day pass is valid for all competition days, and can be purchased over the counter or over the phone — sorry, online booking is not available for the multi-day pass.

Ticket pricing for adults, children under 11, family groups, seniors, and students are as follows:

### **Spotlight on The Weta Cave**

Weta Workshops make models, props, costumes, creatures, vehicles, weapons, and armour for the local and international film industry. Located on a quiet suburban street in Miramar, the Weta Cave is a one room mini-museum designed to give the public a taste of the work that is produced by the creative people employed at Weta Workshops.



If you love models and miniatures, you'll enjoy browsing their collection from the films that Weta have helped make. They have full-sized armour and swords, sci-fi ray guns, tiny models of characters from the Weta films, and a life-sized sculpture of an Uruk-Hai from the Lord of the Rings triology.



The staff at the Weta Cave are extremely knowledgeable and can show you around and answer any questions. There's also a 20 minute DVD presentation that provides a behind the scenes look at the work done by the talented people who work at Weta Worshops. Entry to the Weta Cave is free, so jump on the No 2 Miramar bus and go take a look.
