The Board of International Taekwon-Do Foundation of New Zealand at its meeting on 28 February 2021, proposed the following constitutional amendments.

Amendment 1

That the existing **ARTICLE 43 INTERPRETATION** be renumbered as **ARTICLE 44 INTERPRETATION** to allow for a new Article 43 as per Amendment 2.

Amendment 2

ARTICLE 43.

- 43.1 Anti-doping:** ITFNZ recognises and respects the Drug Free Sport New Zealand Sport Anti-Doping Rules. All relevant persons are bound by them to the extent they are applicable, as outlined by the ITFNZ Anti-doping policy/regulations/by-laws.
- 43.2 Anti-Match-Fixing and related corruption:** ITFNZ is committed to protecting the integrity and reputation of International Taekwon-Do. All relevant persons are bound by the ITFNZ Anti-Match-Fixing policy/regulations/by-laws which describe all prohibited conduct and the breach resolution process.

Reason for Amendment

Sport NZ has a requirement for National Sporting Organisations to have a constitutional level of commitment to anti-doping and integrity in sport (match fixing). This is not reflected in the current constitution.
